

## Peninsula Ballet Theatre Studio Protocols

Please note that COVID-19 represents an ever-changing situation. There will be zero tolerance for anyone not abiding by these protocols, and PBT reserves the right to add or adjust protocols as necessary.

1. **Masks must be worn at all times in and outside the building.** PBT strongly encourages all students to wear N95 masks, KN95 masks, or double mask while in the building.
2. **The PBT lobby is CLOSED.** No parents, guardians, or other visitors are permitted in the studio or lobby areas, unless prior arrangements have been made. Please email [conservatory@penisulaballet.org](mailto:conservatory@penisulaballet.org) with any questions.
3. Students may not arrive more than 10 minutes prior to their class time and MUST depart within 10 minutes of the class's scheduled end time.
4. **If your student (or you if you are the adult student) test positive for COVID-19, and you have attended class in-person, PBT must be notified as soon as possible.**
5. All PBT teachers are testing regularly and are wearing KN95 masks or equivalent.
6. **All in-person classes will also be live-streamed with limited exceptions.** PBT encourages students who are waiting on test results, have been exposed to COVID-19, or are feeling ill to attend class online.
7. If you or your student are sick or exhibiting symptoms of any kind, please stay home.
8. All barres and high-touch surfaces are sanitized regularly.
9. Students and staff must maintain social distancing whenever possible.
10. Students are encouraged to bring their own bottled water and hand sanitizer for class.
11. ALL students must register or enroll in classes via DSP.
12. Bathrooms and all high-touch surfaces are sanitized daily.
13. No cash payments will be accepted until further notice as a means of protection for our staff. Students are encouraged to make payments online through DSP.
